Please note that the Delaware Saengerbund grant for the camp will be \$3,250 for each child selected. All other expenses such as transportation and incidental expenses, beyond the grant amount, will be borne by the parents and/or grandparents.

Bird Watching at the Delaware Saengerbund

Our club has an enviable habitat. There are open spaces, inviting plantings on the edges, a stream and pond in the forest depending on the seasonal rains, and a forest canopy that extends well beyond our boundary. That makes it a desirable habitat for wildlife plantings, bugs, animals, and birds.

That is not a casual statement. Desirable habitats are becoming increasingly lost to the supposed needs of a growing population. Cherishing and protecting our habitat to share with nature is the legacy we owe to our future.

To understand what nature we have on our land, I focused on birds this year. Once a month, I spent a few hours looking at all the areas to find what birds are present. Some birds are residents, some only visit us in the winter and others only in the summer. By checking every month for a year, it is possible to catch sight of those residents and others passing through or spending a short season with us. This process is called doing a Survey.

The last Survey will occur Thursday, Dec. 11. If weather is bad, then Friday, Dec. 12. Always at 8:00 a.m.

Thus far 55 species of birds have been seen/ or heard. Many are known to all: Cardinal, Crow, even Blue Birds. What you may not know is that 5 of the 6 Woodpeckers are residents, including the Pileated. The Redshouldered Hawk has been a long term resident, and birds like Acadia Flycatcher and Eastern Pewee lived here all summer. Juncos and Sapsuckers will be arriving for the winter months. They thank you for the habitat provided. As do I, Lloyd Maier.





The minute you drive up the road, you will notice the gorgeous grounds with luscious flower beds wherever you look.
